6. **Head Teacher's Report:**
  - PC was very pleased with the warm welcome he has received from teachers and pupils alike.
  - Updates:- Pre-lims under way; AH presented the new Facebook page which is targeted at parents. The PC is to consider how to make use of it.; School News, a monthly news sheet to be produced by the 3<sup>rd</sup> year Admin class. The PC could share some space. Noted that the Facebook page is vetted by AH, there is a profanity filter and all photos require consent
