**RE: Changes to form classes**

At the moment all pupils have a designated form class where they are registered every morning, this is also the class where they have PSE (Personal & Social Education) for 1 period a week.

Our S5/6 form classes are already registered in groups with a maximum of 30 pupils, and S1-4 classes with a maximum of 20.

From next year our school roll is set to increase and it is predicted to rise further in the future. While this is a positive sign of our school's success, it does mean that we need to make small changes to ensure that we maximise our ability to continue to deliver a wide and varied curriculum to your children

To that end, from the change of timetable on the 29<sup>th</sup> of May, S1-4 form classes will increase in size to a maximum of 30 pupils. Your child will remain in the same House with the same Pupil Support teacher.

We have considered class lists carefully and assigned pupils to form classes to allow for continuity and a supportive environment for your child. We have also discussed this change with our Parent Council.

If your child is changing form class please find an additional note attached indicating their new form class.
