S1 CHROMEBOOK AUGUST 2017

I am delighted to let you know that your child will receive their Google Chromebook on the afternoon of Thursday 31 August 2017.

Your child will use their Glow username and password to login to their Chromebook. They have used their username a number of times since joining Stirling High and chose their own password last week.

On Thursday, your child will be issued with a Viglen360 Chromebook: <http://viglen.xma.co.uk/chromebook360/> in its original box complete with charger. They will be asked to take the box home and only bring the Chromebook to school. The Chromebook is lightweight and will fit in a schoolbag, but the original box is a little more bulky. You may wish to arrange to pick your child up from school on Thursday if possible. As per the information sent home in June, please encourage them to care for their device and charge it nightly.

I will also be available during the day and after school at certain times during the next few weeks for you to speak to me about our Chromebook scheme and how you can use it to best support your child at home. Drop-in times will be communicated through the school website and our social media channels.

S1s should take their Chromebook to every class. At break and lunch the Chromebook should either remain with them in a school bag or in a locker. At no point should bags containing a Chromebook be left unattended. Bags are allowed into the school servery for this reason.
