Codebase Stirling are running a coding club every Wednesday

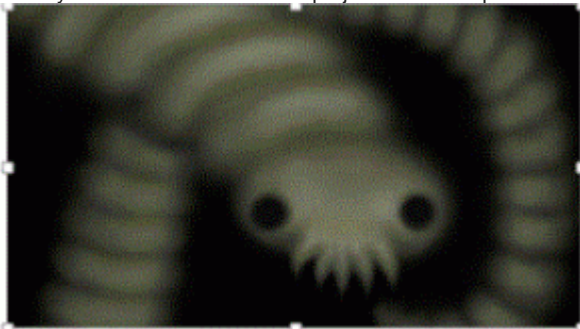
