Purple Day – Friday 24th February February is LGBT – Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender – History Month and on the last Friday of the month we celebrate Purple Friday – a day to stand up against homophobia, biphobia and transphobia and show our support for LGBTI young people. The day was first celebrated in Canada in 2010 and purple signifies the purple stripe on the LGBT rainbow flag which stands for spirit. In 2012 LGBT Youth Scotland surveyed young people living in Scotland and found that 70% had experienced homophobic, biphobia or transphobic bullying in school. 10% said that they had left education

directly because of their experiences. Wear a purple accessory to school e.g. ribbon, socks, scarf to show your support. Normal school uniform must be worn.
