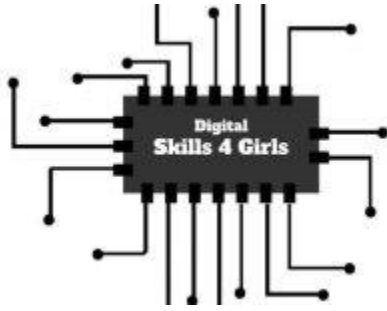

You should contact the individual universities phoning general admissions and explain to them what you wish to drop. They may be OK with your change or they may rescind your offer. If you

still wish to change you must e-mail UCAS at qualsupport@ucas.ac.uk. Your e-mail must include your personal id number and a quick sentence stating that you are dropping a subject.
