Pupil Reports at Stirling High School

We have been working to improve the way that we report your child's progress to you. In session 2017/18 we introduced short regular reports for our young people in the Senior Phase (S4-S6). Feedback from parents/carers and young people was overwhelmingly positive. We have discussed feedback with staff, young people and our Community Partnership (Parent Council).

This session we plan to extend our short, regular reports for young people in S1-S6. The reports will enable you to receive regular feedback on your child's progress.

You will still have the opportunity to meet your child's teachers at our parent and carer evenings. There is one for each year group throughout the session.

You will receive 4 reports throughout this session:

For pupils in S1, S2 and S3 reports will be issued in October, December, February and April. These reports will indicate which Curriculum for Excellence Level your child is working in for each curricular area and also how they are meeting our shared values of respect, responsibility and achievement.

For pupils in S4, S5 and S6 reports will be issued in September, November, January and March. These reports will indicate which course your child is working on in each subject, how well they are progressing towards their target grade and also how they are meeting our shared values of respect, responsibility and achievement.


Shorter, more regular reports will enable you to track your child's progress and for us to work with you to create supports to ensure progression in their next steps.

A major change for this session is the ability for you to view your child's report electronically on-line. We will notify parents and carers by text when you are able to view your child's report. This will make access easier and is a more ecologically friendly way to communicate.

We would like you to support our new on-line eco-friendly way of reporting but if you would prefer a paper copy, please let us know by contacting the school office.

We are very aware that these changes may require future adaptations and we would like your feedback in order that we can improve our reporting processes even more.
